- 2. Anthony Ray, CHRO requests 2 volunteers requested to serve on search committee for **Executive Director of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion.** Volunteers include
 - a. Manuel Salgado (As someone who has participated in all of the equity hiring trainings and someone who has been extensively involved in SSI I am uniquely qualified to assist in the hiring process for this EDI position. In addition, I have extensive experience working on Equity, Diversity, and Inclusive issues as they relate to the teaching and learning process. When this process began, considering the hiring of a Chief Equity Officer, I suggested hiring a consultant to assist with the hiring process because the recruitment, vetting, and hiring of this person cannot be treated lightly. We must seek and ensure a process that is transparent, extensive, and comprehensive. In lieu of this more effective practice (in my opinion), I am volunteering to be an active participant in finding the best person for this position.)
 - b. Arturo Vazquez (I would like to be considered for this volunteer search committee to request faculty representation. I am a great faculty representative, with over 25 years of experience and commitment time to Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion, Examples, Developer of the First International and multicultural recommendations for a candidate of this type of positions at ECC, (initiative first presented to the board back on 2001). MAGIC, 2nd with attempts in 2011 by Joyce. Thanks for your consideration.)
 - c. <u>Maria Bagshaw</u> (Statement of interest: I would be interested in serving on the hiring committee for the Executive Director of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion. This position is a very important one on campus--one that directly supports our college's values and our students. The right candidate needs to be committed to these while also having an understanding that this work is not merely performative, but essential. I should specify that I can only meet after 2:30pm due to my work schedule.)
 - d. <u>Clark Hallpike</u> (The Equity, Diversity and Inclusion director position can be the catalyst that gets ECC to a higher level of understanding and action with regards to social justice. Whom we select matters. I have done an extraordinary amount of work in this area. Here are some highlights: It was you (Kim) and I who introduced Cris Cullinan's workshops on Cultural Competence in Hiring to the

campus. I have been the co-chair of MAGIC (Multicultural And Global Initiatives Committee) for more than a decade. I am currently on SSI (Student Success Infrastructure). The focus of my subcommittee is to improve the success of Black students on campus. I have attended NCORE (National Conference On Race and Ethnicity) for 21 consecutive years. There is where we met Cris Cullinan. There is no doubt that my experience in Equity, Diversity and Inclusion will be an asset to this hiring committee.
