Equity and Student Success Action Council Strategy Team



ESSAC Equity and Student Success Action Council Strategy Team Charges

Gateway Course Completion

This strategy team is charged with the development of recommendations to increase enrollment and completion of college-level English and math in the first year, while seeking to close existing institutional equity gaps in attainment of this metric.

Black Student Success

This strategy team is charged with the development and implementation of a program to increase Black Student Success at ECC. Specifically, practices in the developed program will reduce institutional performance gaps for Black students across the measures of credit accumulation, gateway course completion, term to term retention, and ultimately completion of a credential.

Latinx Student Success / Hispanic Serving Institution Identity

This strategy team is charged with the development and implementation of a program to increase Latinx Student Success at ECC. Specifically, practices in the developed proposal will reduce institutional performance gaps for Latinx students across the measures of credit accumulation, gateway course completion, term to term retention, and ultimately completion of a credential. Additionally, the strategy team will consider ECC's identity as an HSI and propose strategies that enhances this designation from the Dept of Ed.

EDI Professional Development

This strategy team is charged with the development of learning outcomes and employee competencies as it relates to equity, diversity, and inclusion as well as a proposal to enact tactics and strategies to develop employees as trainers, identify outside training resources, and other opportunities to increase capacity in EDI professional development.
