- **Faculty Development**
 - Funding Updates:
 - Full-time Faculty were funded at \$3000 last calendar year. Funding for the upcoming year will be determined at the first committee meeting in January.
 - UAF Faculty were funded at \$3000 for the current fiscal year.
 - Funding reminders:
 - Proposals can be submitted up to a year before or after an event. To meet annual funding deadlines, UAF members need to submit by June 30th. FT members need to submit by December 31st.

Sick Bank

- The Sick Bank Committee is not fully staffed with representation from all of the Divisions. We do not have an official representative from CABS. Due to some real a\spacing out on my part, I forgot to run for reelection, and the person who ran is no longer here. I have been serving as the committee coordinator but I have not been voting. All other divisions are represented.
- o The committee was almost constantly busy this fall, more so than in the recent past. Almost all the requests for days came from non-faculty (Administrators, SEECA members, etc.)
- o Faculty donated 72 days in the fall of 2023 (down from 77 the year before), giving us a starting point of 342.9 days (versus 339.2 the year before) After granting five requests we have 289.7 days at the beginning of the 2024.
- o I will be ending my time on the committee at the end of spring semester. There will be a need for a new chair.
- o I would like to add, that Lesia Gemelli in Human Resources has been a joy to work with.
