# 1. President's Remarks to the ECC Board of Trustees, May 11, 2021

#### Greetings,

I appreciate the opportunity to address the board on behalf of the Elgin Community Faculty Association.

I extend congratulations to the new officers of the Board of Trustees:

ECC has much to be proud of! First, I am proud that the ECC community offered opportunities to celebrate, to critically reflect, and to stand against Asian hate, stereotypes and racism during Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month.

I celebrate our newly tenured faculty who have committed to making a career and a home at Elgin Community College:

In the spirit of our shared values, equity and diversity, ECCFA is advocating for HB 3145 as the bill's intent is to provide greater opportunity for diversity of representation at the geographic and demographic levels. We know that professing our shared values are not the same as embracing them and living them out authentically. ECCFA sees supporting this legislation, HB 3145, as an opportunity to move ECC, the ECC BOT and community college district 509, in the right direction, a move toward advancing equity in support of equitable representation for the communities we serve.

# Investments: Clark Hallpike serves as ECCFA Representative to the Administration regarding 403b and 457b

ECC currently provides employees with two opportunities to invest pre-tax income. They are a 403b and 457b. Employees can select one of four companies at ECC for the 403b and as of today, one company with the 457b which is Lincoln Investment. The state of Illinois has mandated that ECC must carry a second option for the 457b which will be orchestrated by SURS, and SURS has selected VOYA. On July 1, we will then have two options for the 457b. They companies are Lincoln Investment and VOYA.

The idea that drives investing pre-tax funds is that you are reducing your current taxable income, but you will pay taxes, when the funds are withdrawn at a later time. The assumption is that your tax bracket is likely to be less at the later time of withdrawal. It would be wise to become familiar with the attached documents for more information, or you may consult your certified financial planner (CFP).
