# 5. OLD BUSINESS

- a. **SLAAC Bylaws.** Senators received a copy of the SLAAC Bylaws by email. Peggy moved to approve the SLAAC Bylaws. Stacey seconded. The motion carried.
- b. Testing Center & Accommodations. Peggy Heinrich is looking into procedures to improve the testing center, including opening earlier. The college is also working on designing a best practice for accommodating students. Senators discussed the need for a clear definition of "reasonable" when extending due dates. Faculty with accommodation concerns should reach out to Pietrina Probst.
- **c. Dual Credit.** Peggy Heinrich was unaware of the situation with Bartlett High School students Zooming in for dual credit at another high school. She believes there is precedent for that in the CTE department.
- **d.** Cultural Competency Training. ECCFA requested adequate time to complete the training and be informed about whether we need to retrain. The college is going to honor that request.
- e. Opening Day. Kim will work on reserving the dining room in Building E and getting a menu for food options.
- f. Textbooks and CurricuNet. Instructional coordinators will receive a spreadsheet to update textbooks for course outlines. The college is hoping to update that information across the college by May 24.
- g. Mandatory Training Email from Anthony Ray. Senators discussed the additional required training and expressed their frustration at the extra work. The contract requirements were discussed. These trainings were negotiated by the administration and ECCFA. They can be completed during office hours. Senators commented on how poorly designed ECC-created trainings are.

- **h.** Senate Meeting Start Time. A Senator whose class runs until 3:15 pm wants to attend the full meeting. Senators discussed the meeting start time.
- 6. New BUSINESS
